



Study a foreign language with CONAHEC!

Facility in a foreign language is a skill that college graduates in a variety of fields are finding increasingly useful. Students at CONAHEC member institutions now have access to a number of different Spanish language programs in Mexico, Spain, and Colombia, as well as programs in Portuguese and Korean. Studying a foreign language abroad provides far better results than coursework in one's native country, and of course the experience will create memories that last a lifetime.

No fees are paid to CONAHEC for participation in the Student Exchange Program. Students pay tuition to their home university.

Courses may be offered during the school year, during the summer, or as short courses to prepare for traditional coursework. Extra costs for room, board, and travel apply unless otherwise stated. Please contact the prospective host university for more information.
